## **An Avenue of Mansions – St. Paul Style**

Tour St. Paul's Summit Avenue from the comfort of a motor coach. Discover



who lives or lived in some of the most notable homes along this famous street. Lunch will be served at Forepaugh's, a historic Victorian Manor, turned into a restaurant serving the finest French Cuisine. The lunch menu includes Vol au Vent du Poulet (tender pieces of chicken with mushrooms, a light cream sauce, and a touch of sherry in a puff pastry shell), French bread and of course - dessert.

After lunch the tour continues at the "grand daddy" of all the mansions - the James J. Hill House. Tour guides will give a brief history of the Hill family and lead the tour of this wonderfully preserved home. The builder of the Great Northern Railway, James J. Hill built this home in 1891 for the public and private lives of his family. Wouldn't Mr. Hill be surprised that 117 years later, the public is still enjoying the splendor of his home?

## Menomonie – A Town of Very Old Surprises

Menomonie, Wisconsin is much more than the newest Wisconsin rest stop on Interstate 94. The town holds many surprises beginning with the Mabel Tainter Memorial Theater. This center for performing and visual arts has brought cultural excellence to the Chippewa Valley since it was commissioned in 1889 by Captain and Bertha Tainter as a memorial to their young daughter, Mabel. This elegant facility is listed on the National Register of Historic Theaters and is a Wisconsin Historic Marker destination. The 116 year old “jewel box” Victorian theater hosts a diverse season of musical and dramatic performances, visual art exhibits, and special cultural events throughout the year. (Perhaps you can return on your own and attend one of those venues.)

Lunch will be served at another historic building – Olde Towne. After lunch you may tour this unique building and its collections. The final stop of the day will be the Wilson Place Mansion, home of a Midwestern lumber baron family. Learn about 130 years of changing tastes and lifestyles of the Wilson family. The Wilson Place experience focuses on the High Victorian era, the period of the family’s greatest wealth.

Tour departs at 8:45 a.m. from the District Education Center (2520 E. 12th Ave., North St. Paul) and returns about 4:30 p.m. to the same location (no building access for bathrooms or telephone use). Tour includes guided tour of the Theater, Wilson mansion, inclusive lunch, deluxe motor coach and tour escort, Julie Ahlman of J & M Tours.

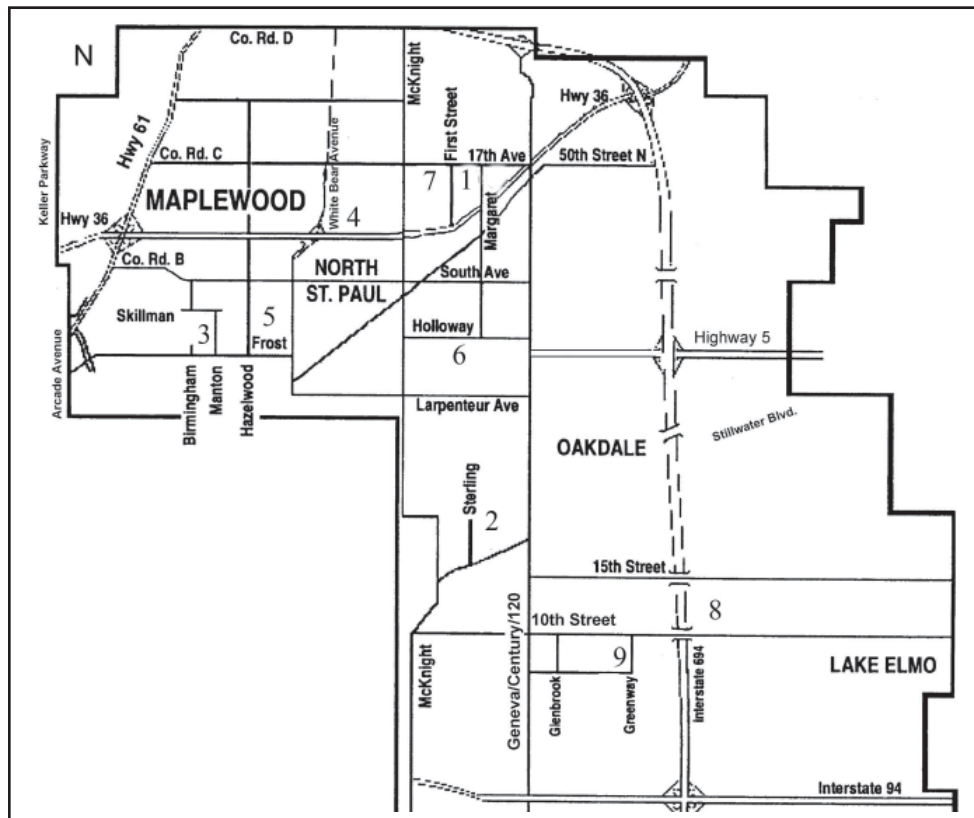
