District 622 Education Center

2520 E. 12th Ave. North St. Paul, 55109

From Hwy 36, north on McKnight Rd; right on 11th Ave. Go past the High School to the next building. Park in the east lot.

Demontreville Lake

From Hwy 694, east on Hwy 36, right on Highland hills Trail.

Turn onto Demontreville Trail. Boat launch/parking is just north of the intersection of Demontreville Trail and 53rd St.

Fairview Community Center

1910 W. County Road B, Roseville, 55113

From Hwy 36 in Roseville, south on Fairview, right on Co. Rd. B.

Maplewood Bowl

From Hwy 36, south on White Bear Ave, left into parking lot at intersection of White Bear Ave and Frost.

Saints North Roller Skating

From Hwy 36, north on White Bear Ave. Left on Gervais and left on Gervais Court (just past the large apartment complex).

Science Museum of Minnesota

120 W. Kellogg Boulevard, St. Paul, 55101

From I-94 West, take the 12th Street exit and follow to Jackson Street. Turn left (south) to Kellogg Blvd; right onto Kellogg, and continue six blocks - museum will be on your left. Be sure you are in the left lane and follow the Exchange Street underpass, which goes under Kellogg Blvd. Continue down Exchange to Eagle and take a left; left on Chestnut and proceed to the lower parking entrance.

White Bear Lake Area High School South Campus

3551 McKnight Road, White Bear Lake, 55110

School is south of County Rd. E, on McKnight Rd. *Let's Go Twin Cities* trips leave from the southwest parking lot.
